Day and night work: Coral Tree Drive substation connections

Dear resident,

NorthConnex is building a power substation at Coral Tree Drive to supply electricity to the NorthConnex Motorway Control Centre and tunnel for operational lighting, ventilation and water treatment. To connect power to the substation, the project team is installing underground electricity cables from Coral Tree Drive, Carlingford to the Carlingford transmission station, on the corner of Pennant Hills Road and Jenkins Road via Oakes Road.

This work is generally carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**, however for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, some work is also carried out at night **between 9pm and 5am Sunday to Friday**.

We will be working at night **from 9pm Thursday 6 September to 5am Friday 7 September 2018**, weather permitting, to install an electrical pole on Oakes Road next to the northbound lane between the Hills M2 Motorway overpass and Carmen Drive, Carlingford. If work is delayed, it will be done on the next available night shift.

Plant and equipment for this work includes a 50 tonne crane, elevated work platform, lighting towers, cable pulling equipment, power and hand tools, heavy and light vehicles, and generators.

You will experience noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- consulting with directly affected residents
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use.

To carry out the work safely, Oakes Road will be closed to motorists between Mundon Place and Carmen Drive **from 10.30pm Thursday 6 September to 4am Friday 7 September 2018**. A detour will be in place via North Rocks Road, Pennant Hills Road, and Eaton Road. The bus stop and five minute 'kiss and ride' parking area on Oakes Road northbound will be relocated 50 metres north during this work. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and property owners. A map of the detour, bus stop and parking relocation areas is provided over the page.

To facilitate installation and connection of underground cables, the Oakes Road northbound bus stop under the Hills M2 Motorway will be temporarily relocated 50 metres north and parking will be restricted for two weeks. Signs will be in place to notify commuters in advance of the bus stop and parking relocation.
