Coral Tree Drive substation cable connections

Dear resident,

As part of work to construct the Coral Tree Drive power substation, the project team will be installing underground electricity cables from Coral Tree Drive to the Carlingford transmission station, on the corner of Pennant Hills Road and Jenkins Road via Oakes Road. There are no planned interruptions to your services as part of this work. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

The substation will supply electricity to the NorthConnex tunnel for operational lighting, ventilation, water treatment and will also power the Motorway Control Centre at the tunnel's Southern Interchange on the corner of Pennant Hills Road and the Hills M2 Motorway.

Work is expected to start on Monday 26 March and take about six months to complete, weather permitting.

The majority of this work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays**, however for the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, some work may also be carried out at night **between 9pm and 5am Sunday to Friday**. We will provide advance notice of work outside your property and before the start of night work.

Work will include:

- minor vegetation trimming
- locating utility services through shallow excavation of the road, footpath or verge
- excavating and trenching the road, footpath or verge
- installing conduits (plastic pipes)
- pulling cables and joining connections
- backfilling and restoring the road surface, footpath or verge at the completion of work.

Temporary parking and access changes

We expect to be working outside your property for about four days, subject to ground conditions, with cable installation progressing at a rate of about 25 metres per day. This means you won't be able to access your driveway at times during our working hours and parking on the road will be restricted for up to two days. There will be traffic diversions in place and some changes to pedestrian access while this work is taking place.

Plant and equipment for this work includes concrete saws, hand held drills, jackhammers, excavators, dump trucks, compaction equipment, vacuum truck, cable pulling equipment and generators.

You will experience noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

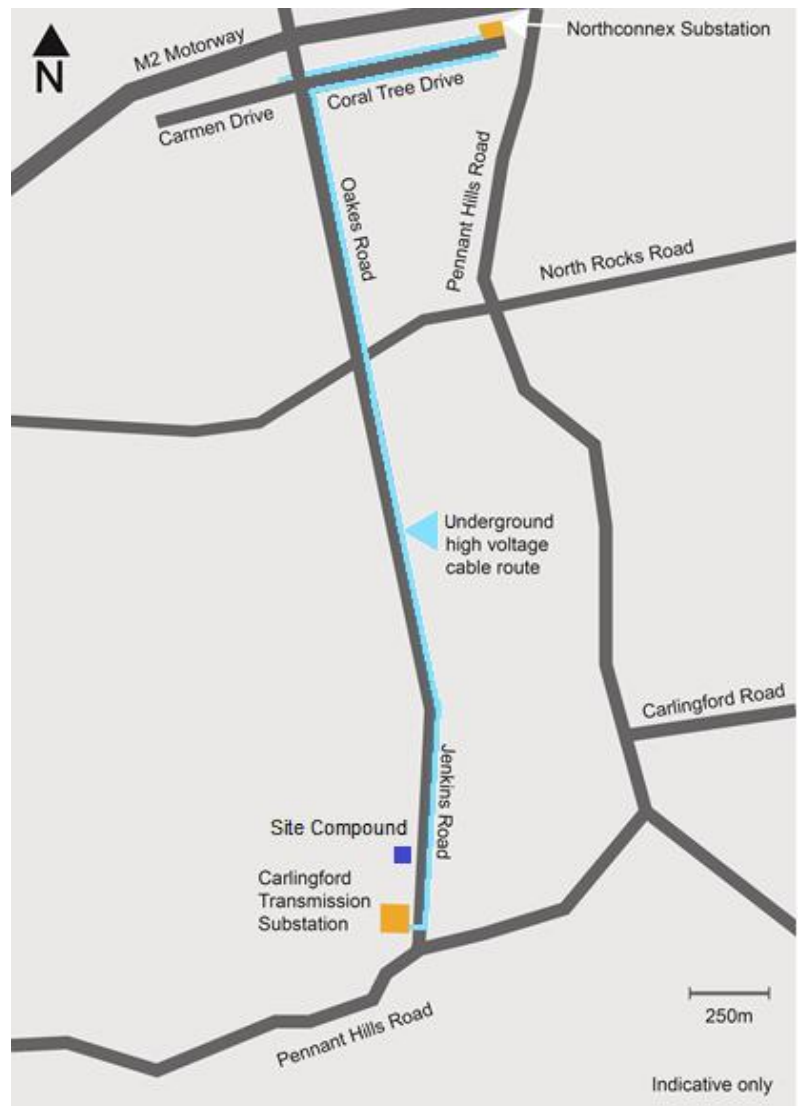
- consulting with directly affected residents
- not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for noisy work
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using solar-powered lighting towers.

Traffic changes, signage, traffic controllers and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
