Night work: temporary closure of the footbridge between Woonona Avenue and John Hughes Place, Wahroonga

Dear resident,

As part of the NorthConnex tunnelling work, maintenance work will be carried out on the pedestrian footbridge between Woonona Avenue on the eastern side of the M1 Pacific Motorway to John Hughes Place, Wahroonga. The work will be carried out from the surface of the M1 Pacific Motorway and will involve concrete cutting and welding over three nights, weather permitting. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

To ensure the safety of motorists and workers, work will be carried out at night when the traffic volumes are lower. Work will be carried out between 10pm and 5am from Sunday 17 September 2017 and is expected to be completed over three nights, weather permitting. If work is unable to take place as scheduled, it will be carried out the following week in the same three day sequence.

Plant and equipment for this work includes an elevated work platform, a mobile 60 tonne crane, saw cutter, welding machine and hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > Advising directly affected residents via letter
- > Limiting work to three consecutive nights in one week
- > Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use.

Pedestrian footpath closure

The footbridge between Woonona Avenue on the eastern side of the M1 and John Hughes Place, Wahroonga will be closed between 10pm and 5am from Sunday 17 September to Tuesday 19 September. The footpath will remain open during the day. Temporary pedestrian diversions will be in place via Warwilla Avenue, Coonanbarra Road, Millewa Avenue, Alexandria Parade and Ingram Road, Wahroonga.

If you travel along this route at night, please allow extra travel time and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signage.
