Installation of a Pennant Hills Road gantry, Beecroft / West Pennant Hills

We are progressing with plans to install a gantry on Pennant Hills Road as part of the compliance regulations that will see trucks required to use the NorthConnex tunnel, unless they have a genuine destination accessed via Pennant Hills Road.

As you know, the NSW Government is delivering NorthConnex, a nine-kilometre tunnel that will link the M1 Pacific Motorway at Wahroonga to the Hills M2 Motorway at West Pennant Hills.

NorthConnex will allow motorists and around 5,000 heavy vehicles per day to bypass Pennant Hills Road, providing more reliable and safer travel conditions, while also returning local streets to local communities. The project will also help to reduce traffic noise on Pennant Hills Road for nearby residents.

This gantry will monitor trucks on Pennant Hills Road, and be located near the intersections of Hannah Street and Oratava Avenue. We have included a map over the page showing the location of the gantry and electronic message sign, which also needs to be relocated.

What will our work involve?

Our work to install the gantry will involve five stages:

1. Setting up the site
2. Relocating underground utility services
3. Installing the footings for the gantry and electronic message sign
4. Installing the enforcement gantry and electronic message sign
5. Connecting the gantry and electronic message sign to the Intelligent Transport System.

Most of our work will occur on Pennant Hills Road. Some work to relocate underground utilities and install the gantry footing will also be carried out on Hannah Street, Oratava Avenue, Eaton Road and Karloon Road.

When will the gantry be built?

Our work is expected to start in September 2019. We will complete most of this work at night to minimise impact on traffic and to keep our workers and the community safe. Some of this work may be noisy but we will have measures in place to help reduce this noise.
