Night work update: Hills M2 Motorway and Pennant Hills Road on and off ramps

Dear resident,

NorthConnex will continue to carry out night work at a number of locations across a 4.8 kilometre stretch of the Hills M2 Motorway between Pennant Hills and Windsor Road from **Friday 24 February 2017**.

Closure of the eastbound off ramp to Pennant Hills Road

To facilitate work to modify the eastbound off ramp at Pennant Hills Road and create a northbound entry to the NorthConnex tunnel and a cycleway structure, the eastbound off ramp will be closed on **Friday 24 February 2017 between 9pm and 7am and Sunday 26 February 2017 between 9pm and 5am, weather permitting**. Work will include installing safety barriers and crash cushions and modifying line marking. Vehicles will not be able to use the off ramp during these times. A map of the work area is provided.

Night work is planned to minimise delays for motorists travelling during peak travel times on the Hills M2 Motorway and to ensure the safety of workers. If the work is unable to take place on these dates it will be rescheduled to the next available night shift.

There will be two alternative detour routes in place for motorists. A map of the alternative detour routes is provided. The primary detour is via Windsor Road, Old Northern Road, Terminus Street, Old Northern Road, Castle Hill Road and Pennant Hills Road.

A secondary detour is via Lane Cove Road, Pacific Highway and Pennant Hills Road.

Roads and Maritime Services has approved all roads identified in the detours for B Doubles (heavy vehicles).

Darling Mills Creek Bridge Girder Installation

As part of ongoing work to widen the Hills M2 Motorway, work to prepare and install bridge support beams at Darling Mills Creek Bridge and modify temporary scaffolding on the ramp to the Barclay Road Interchange bus stop will take place on **Saturday 25 February 2017 between 7pm and 9am and Sunday 26 February 2017 between 7pm and 5am, weather permitting**. A map of the work area is provided.

Night work is planned to minimise delays for motorists travelling during peak travel times on the Hills M2 Motorway and to ensure the safety of workers. If the work is unable to take place as scheduled, it will be carried out on the following weekend on **Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 March 2017**.

Changes to bus service – 7pm to 9am Saturday 25 February and 7pm to 5am Sunday 26 February 2017

During this work the Barclay Road Interchange bus stop will be closed. A free shuttle bus will connect bus commuters from the closest bus stop in an eastbound direction on Oakes Road to the Barclay Road Interchange car park. Signage will be in place to guide customers.

A full list of ongoing construction activities are listed in the table enclosed. Work will be carried out at night between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday to ensure the safety of motorists and workers.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes (various sizes), light vehicles, lighting towers, rattle guns, generators, knuckle boom lift, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, excavators, core drill, street sweeper, water carts, concrete saws, jack hammers power tools and hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- consulting with directly affected residents
- not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for noisy work
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using solar-powered lighting towers.

Traffic changes, traffic controllers and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.

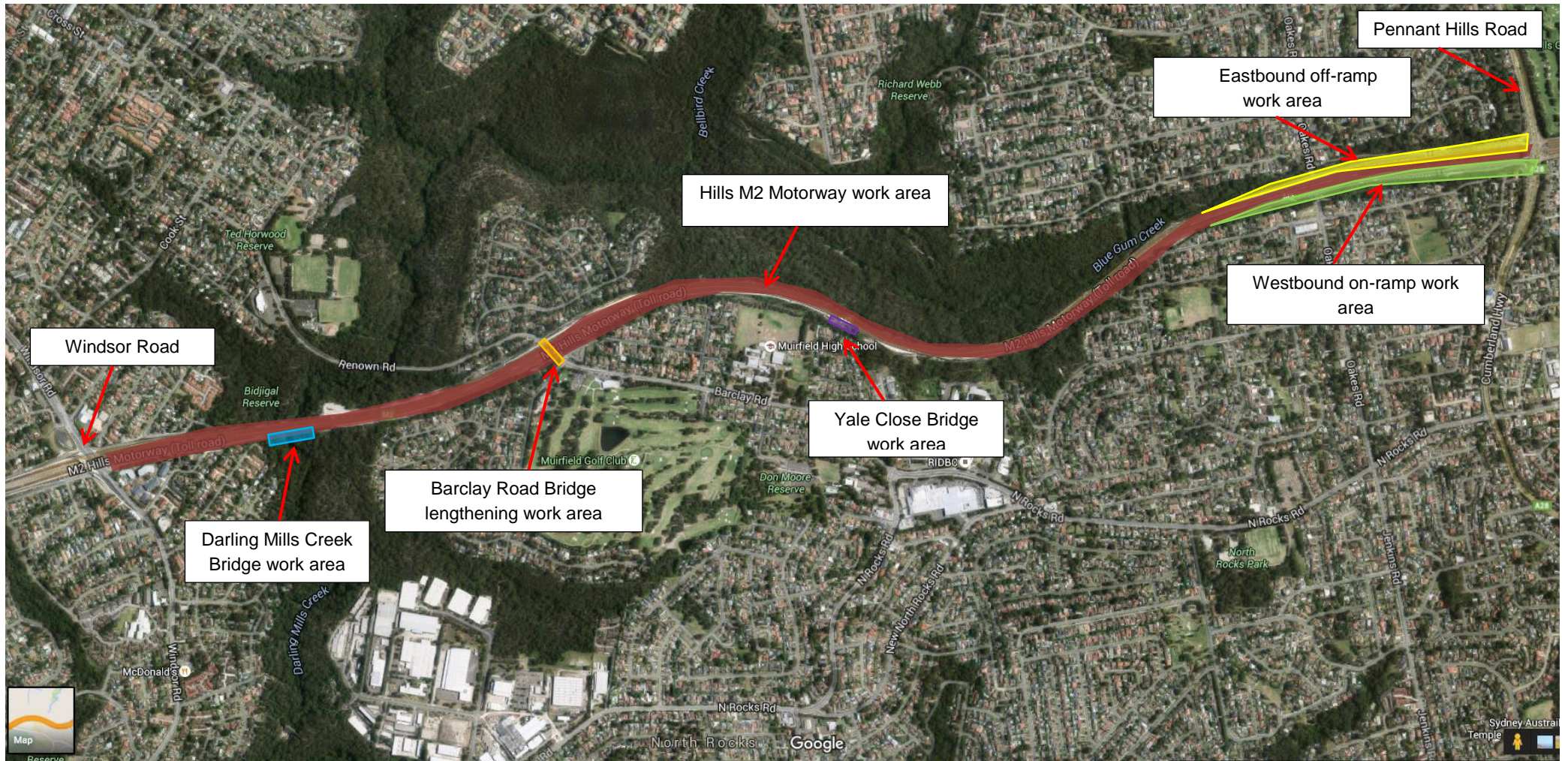

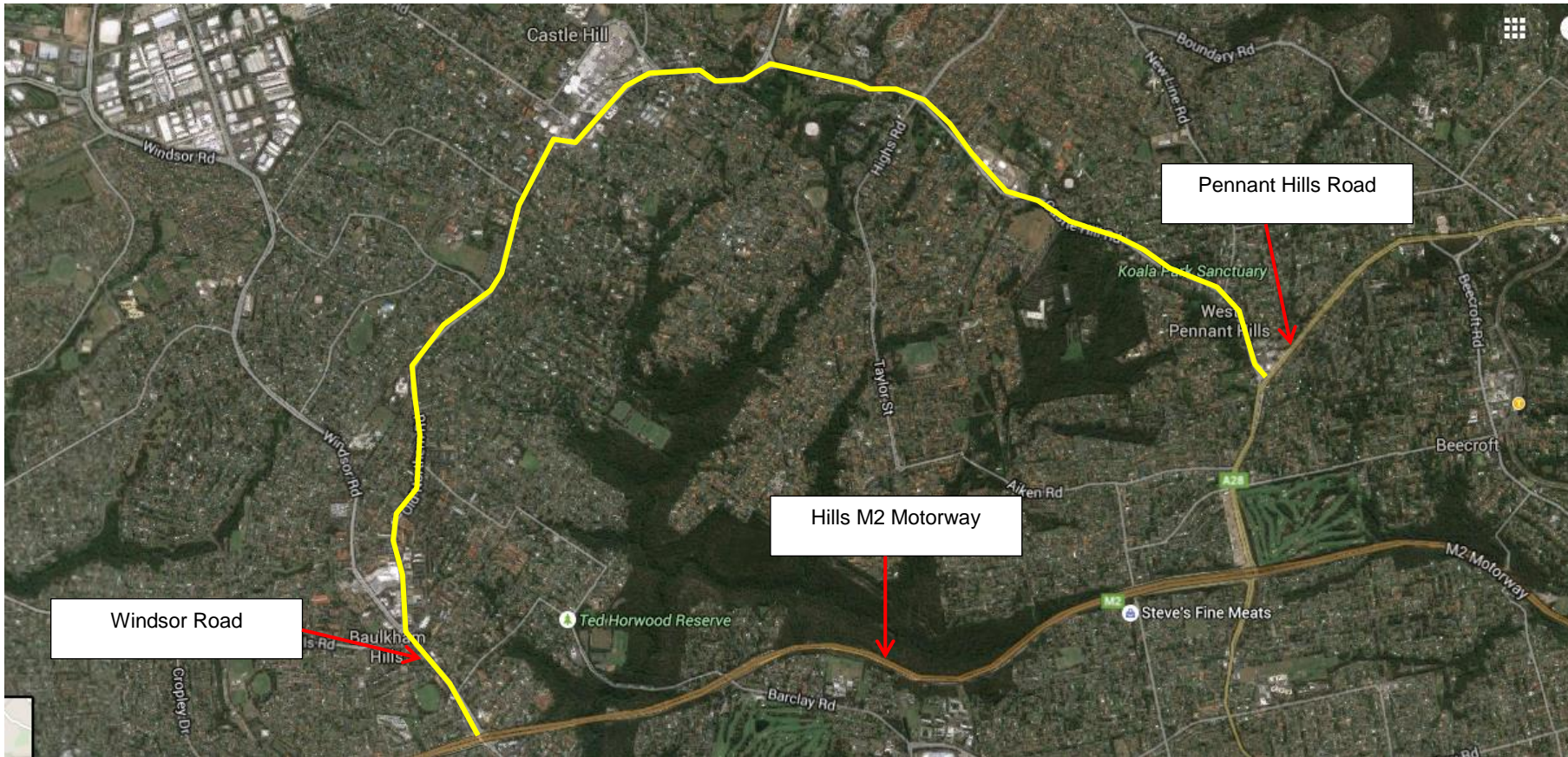

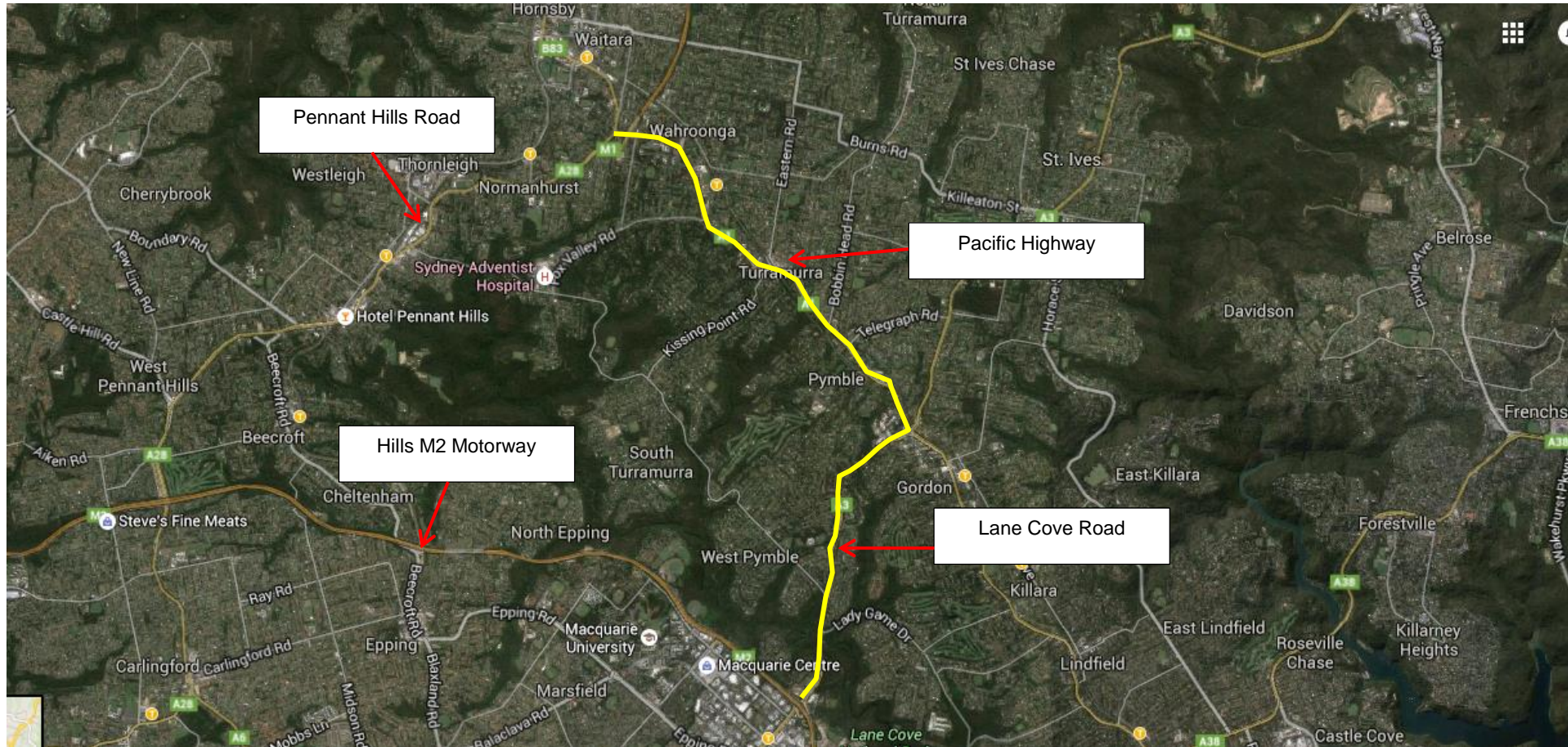


Primary motorist detour route
