Night work: Pennant Hills Road – construction of new entry into Wilson Road Compound, Pennant Hills

This is further to our previous information about the Wilson Road Compound set up in November 2015.

Night work on Pennant Hills Road between Loftus Road and Wilson Road will be carried out to construct a new access road, via a slip lane, into the compound directly off Pennant Hills Road. This will be of benefit to the local community with the majority of heavy vehicles entering and exiting the site directly off Pennant Hills Road.

Due to high volumes of traffic on Pennant Hills Road, most of the work will need to be done at night and will include:

- Removal of vegetation in front of properties adjacent to the compound
- Removal of brick boundary wall
- Removal and replacement of street lights and power poles
- Construction of slip lane into the compound
- Construction of pedestrian walkway parallel to slip lane.

To avoid disruption to traffic on Pennant Hills Road, work will be carried out at night between **9pm and 5am** for five nights each week from **5 February to 24 March 2016**. Where possible, some work will be done during the day. Workers and vehicles will access the Wilson Road Compound between 7pm and 7am. Please note if the work is unable to be completed on these days, it will be rescheduled. (See page 2 for dates of night work and the work location).

Equipment to be used will include an excavator, dump truck, chainsaw, generator concrete trucks, concrete vibrators, lights, concrete saw and drills. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Parking away from homes
- Noise monitoring to ensure compliance with noise limits
- Scheduling work to take place no more than two nights in a row and limiting work to no more than three nights in one week at the same location
- Coordinating respite for residents most affected by the noise.

Traffic management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Variable message signs will be in place to advise of the changes to traffic conditions.
