## Night work – Pennant Hills Road southbound realignment

Dear Resident

As part of ongoing work to build the NorthConnex southbound tunnel exit, night work is continuing to prepare for the realignment of the Pennant Hills Road southbound lanes between Murray Farm Road and Hannah Street. A map of the work area is provided over the page.

This work will restart in **February** and is expected to be completed in mid March, weather permitting.

The work involves:

- > moving and installing concrete barriers
- > removing existing line markings and painting new line markings
- > relocating traffic signals
- > installing new road signs.

## Upcoming permanent changes to traffic

Once the work is completed, traffic travelling southbound along Pennant Hills Road will be moved onto the new lanes. Motorists will be advised of these changes using variable message signs and [livetraffic.com](http://livetraffic.com)

## How will the work affect you?

You may experience some noise during some of these activities, we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and machinery when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for high noise generating activities.

### Work hours

Night work – 8pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday. Saturday night work may occur as required.
