Night work: pavement and drainage, M1 Pacific Motorway and Pennant Hills Road Wahroonga

Dear resident,

As part of the construction of the new two lane southbound road bridge which will take traffic from the M1 Pacific Motorway to Pennant Hills Road, the project team will carry out pavement and drainage work on and adjacent to Pennant Hills Road and the M1 Pacific Motorway, Wahroonga. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

To ensure the quality of the new pavement, work will start on **Friday 1 September at 10am and continue through until 10am on Sunday 3 September 2017**, weather permitting. If work is unable to take place as scheduled, it will be carried out the following week in the same three day sequence.

The main work activities include:

- > Excavating existing road and pavement
- > Removing redundant services
- > Installing new drainage
- > Constructing road pavement
- > Concreting.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes, excavators, bob cat, jack hammers, heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, generators, rattle guns, hammer drills, grinders, concrete trucks, street sweepers, vacuum trucks, water carts and pumps, concrete saws and pumps, core drills, as well as hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > providing a one hour respite between three hour blocks of continual work generating high noise
- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > providing respite for residents most affected by noise

- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using solar-powered lighting towers and directing light away from residential properties where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

There will be day and night closures of the southbound slow lanes on the M1 Pacific Motorway and Pennant Hills Road between the M1 Pacific Motorway near Kingsley Close and Pennant Hills Road near Frith Avenue.

Day work will take place under a single southbound lane closure between **10am and 6pm Friday**; and between **9am and 6pm on Saturday**.

Night work will take place under a double southbound lane closure between **6pm on Friday and 9am on Saturday**; and between **6pm Saturday to 10am on Sunday**.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Access for motorists and pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
