Night work update: Hills M2 Motorway

Dear resident,

NorthConnex will continue to carry out night work at a number of locations across a 4.8 kilometre stretch of the Hills M2 Motorway between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road, to prepare for the opening of the dedicated bus lane. For the safety of workers and to minimise delays for motorists, this work will be carried out at night. A map of the work area is included in this notification.

Activities leading to the opening will include pavement and concrete works, line marking and realignment of safety barriers. Eastbound and westbound night time lane closures will be in place between:

- **8pm to 7am on Friday 2 February**, weather permitting
- **8pm to 9am on Saturday 3 February 2018**, weather permitting.

Temporary closure of the Barclay Road Bus Interchange

For the safety of workers, motorists and bus customers, during the lane closures above the bus stop will be closed. A free shuttle bus will connect customers from the Barclay Road Interchange car park to the Oakes Road bus stop. Signage will be in place to guide customers.

If the work is unable to be completed on this date it will be rescheduled to the next available night shift, which may be the following weekend.

Closure of the Hills M2 Motorway westbound off ramp at Windsor Road

As part of road resurfacing work, a full closure of the westbound off ramp at Windsor Road will be in place between:

- **9pm to 5am on Friday 9 February**, weather permitting
- **9pm to 5am on Saturday 10 February**, weather permitting.

If the work is unable to be completed on these dates it will be rescheduled to the next available night shift.

During this work the off ramp will be closed to all traffic. There will be an alternative detour route for motorists. Motorists are encouraged to use the detour route via Old Windsor Road, James Ruse Drive and Windsor Road. A map of the detour route is included.

Roads and Maritime Services has approved all roads identified in the detours for B Doubles (heavy vehicles).

If traffic volumes are low, the westbound off ramp may be closed before the times indicated. Motorists are advised to follow the electronic messaging boards.

Closure of the Hills M2 eastbound off ramp to Pennant Hills Road

To facilitate work to modify the eastbound off ramp at Pennant Hills Road and create a northbound entry to the NorthConnex tunnel and a cycleway structure, the eastbound off ramp will be closed between:

- **9pm to 5am on Thursday 8 February**, weather permitting
- **9pm to 5am on Sunday 11 February**, weather permitting
- **9pm to 5am on Monday 12 February**, weather permitting
- **9pm to 5am on Tuesday 13 February**, weather permitting.

If the work is unable to be completed on these dates it will be rescheduled to the next available night shift. During this work the on ramp will be closed to all traffic.

Work will include decommissioning and removal of an existing toll gantry and commissioning of a new gantry.

There will be two alternative detour routes in place for motorists. A map of the alternative detour routes is provided. The primary detour is via Windsor Road, Old Northern Road, Terminus Street, Old Northern Road, Castle Hill Road and Pennant Hills Road.

A secondary detour is via Lane Cove Road, Pacific Highway and Pennant Hills Road.

Roads and Maritime Services has approved all roads identified in the detours for B Doubles (heavy vehicles).

If traffic volumes are low, the eastbound off ramp may be closed before the times indicated. Motorists are advised to follow the electronic messaging boards.

Ongoing construction activities around the Hills M2 Motorway

A full list of ongoing construction activities are listed in the enclosed table. To ensure the safety of motorists and workers this work will generally be carried out at night between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday. Some work will be carried out between 7pm and 9am on Friday and Saturday nights as required.

Plant and equipment includes cranes (various sizes), light vehicles, lighting towers, rattle guns, generators, knuckle boom lift, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, pumps and vibrators, sucker truck, excavators with attachments, asphalt pavers, line markers, bobcat, core drill, street sweeper, water carts, concrete saws, piling rigs, profilers, jack hammers, hammer drill, grinders, power tools and hand tools.

You may experience some noise during this work and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- consulting with directly affected residents
- not working more than three nights a week and no more than two nights consecutively for noisy work

- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using solar-powered lighting towers.

Traffic changes, traffic controllers and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.

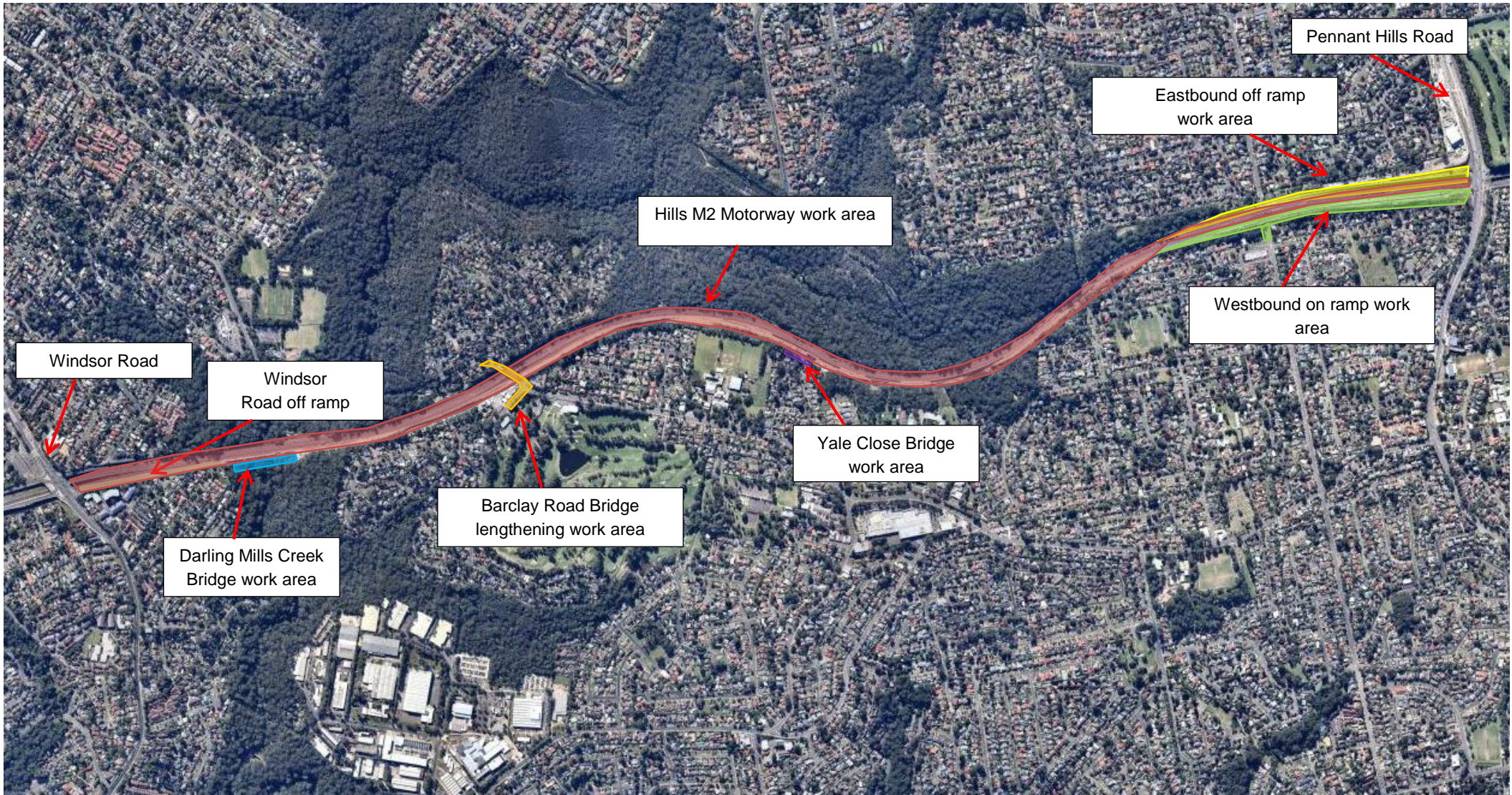

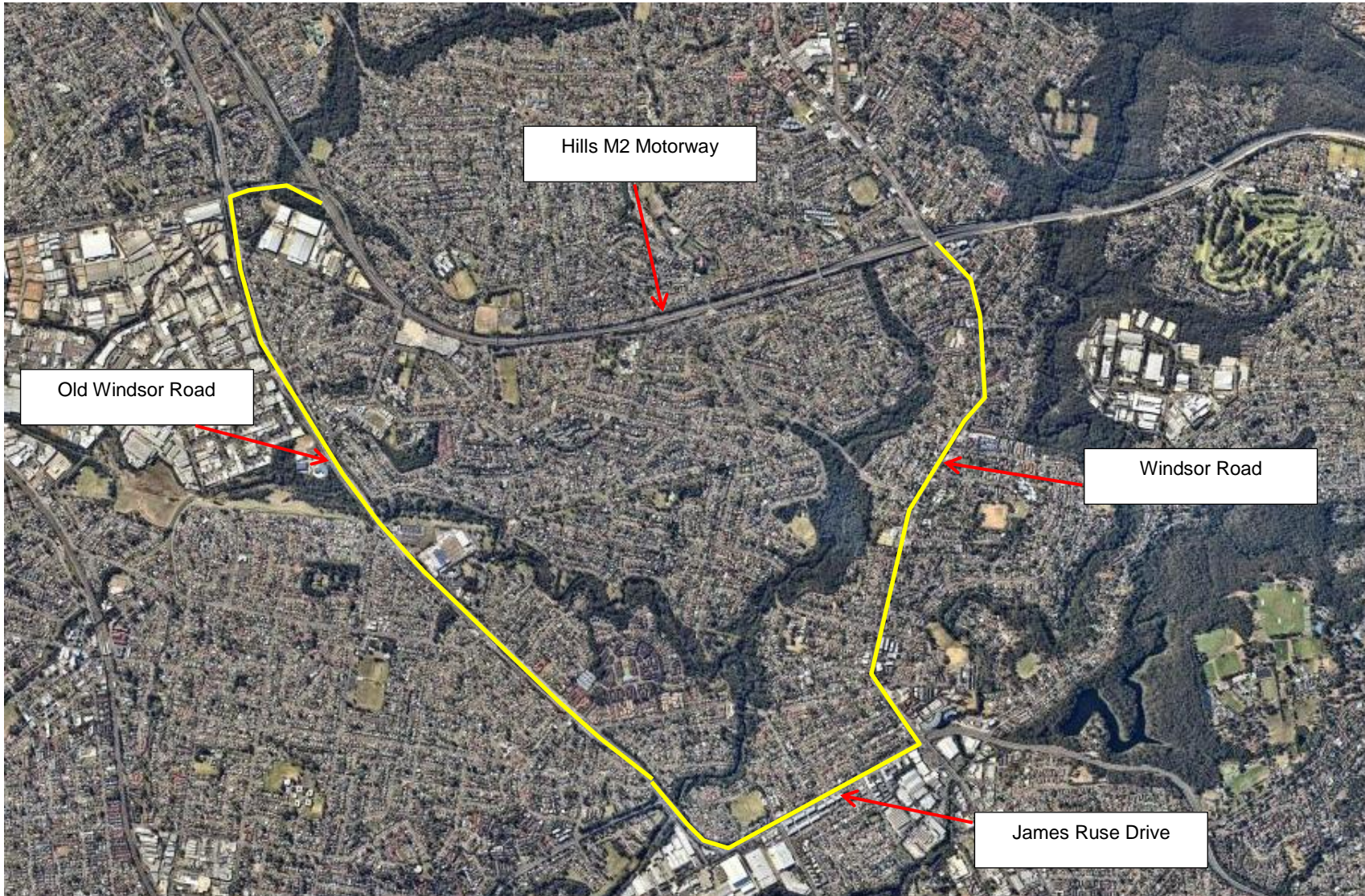
