Night work: Permanent electronic message sign on Castle Hill Road, West Pennant Hills

Dear Resident,

Permanent electronic message signs have been installed as part of the NorthConnex project. The signs provide road users with up-to-date information on traffic conditions and planned and unplanned incidents and events.

We will be working at the sign on Castle Hill Road, near the Koala Park Sanctuary, **between 9pm and 5am on Wednesday 3 April and Thursday 4 April, 2019**, weather permitting. If work is delayed it will be done on the next available night shift.

A map of the work area is provided.

How will the work affect you?

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using lighting towers only when necessary
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.
