## Night work: Concrete pour at the Northern Interchange, M1 Pacific Motorway Wahroonga

Dear Resident

As part of the construction of the new M1 southbound off ramp the project team will carry out a concrete pour at the Northern Interchange near the M1 Pacific Motorway, Wahroonga. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

Work will start on **Thursday 8 December at 5pm and continue through until the afternoon of Friday 9 December 2016**, weather permitting. During this work, about 485 cubic metres of concrete will be poured continuously and left to set. This is required to ensure the new off ramp is of high quality. Residents are encouraged to register for SMS updates and respite by contacting us on 1800 997 057 or enquiries@northconnex.com.au.

The main work activities include:

- > Delivery of concrete from Mount Ku-ring-gai batching plant to site in about 58 loads over nine hours
- > Pouring of concrete.

Plant and equipment for this work includes a crane, concrete vibrator needles, concrete pumps, light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum truck, generators, excavators, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, street sweeper, water cart, concrete saws and hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > Consulting directly affected residents
- > Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > Using noise blankets, where practicable, on the noisiest equipment (eg generators)
- > Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > Using solar-powered lighting towers, and directing lighting away from residents and motorists.
