## Night work: M1 Pacific Motorway traffic realignment, Wahroonga

Dear resident

As part of ongoing M1 Pacific Motorway widening work, the project team is temporarily diverting northbound and southbound traffic onto the median between Alexandria Parade Bridge to 700 metres north of Edgeworth David Avenue, Wahroonga. Work to realign the southbound traffic lanes to temporarily divert traffic is continuing until late March 2017.

The northbound traffic realignment was completed in late January. The traffic realignment will be in place until late 2019 to allow us to safely build the northbound tunnel exit ramp, southbound tunnel entry ramp, northern ventilation outlet and noise walls.

Due to the high traffic volumes on the M1 Pacific Motorway and for the safety of workers and motorists the work is taking place at night between 9pm and 5am Sunday to Friday. There is no work on Saturday nights.

The main work activities include:

- > Asphaltting
- > Removing one kilometre of concrete barriers in the M1 median between Alexandria Parade and 700 metres north of Edgeworth David Avenue
- > Removing existing line marking and installing new line marking
- > Relocating the barriers to the northbound and southbound shoulders between Alexandria Parade and Edgeworth David Avenue
- > Installing road work signage to indicate the new traffic arrangement.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes, light vehicles, lighting towers, rattle guns, hammer drills, grinders, generators, semi-trailers, rollers, a bob cat, concrete trucks, a street sweeper, a water cart, concrete saws and core drills, line marking and removal plant and hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > Ensuring noisy work is not undertaken more than three nights in one week
- > Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > Using solar-powered lighting towers.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
