## Night work: Service investigation work on Pennant Hills Road between the Hills M2 Motorway and Murray Farm Road, Beecroft

Dear resident

As part of ongoing work to realign Pennant Hills Road and build the southbound tunnel exit ramp, work to locate services will be carried out to help design a new breakdown bay on Pennant Hills Road between the Hills M2 Motorway and Murray Farm Road, Beecroft. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

To ensure the safety of motorists and workers and minimise impact on traffic flow, this work will be carried out at night between **9pm and 5am on Sunday 9 July and Monday 10 July 2017, weather permitting**. If the work is unable to take place on this date it will be rescheduled to the next available night shift.

Work will include:

- excavating and trenching
- potholing
- commissioning and testing
- removing and replacing sections of pavement
- asphaltting.

Plant and equipment includes light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum trucks, jackhammer, trucks, compactor, water cart, concrete saws and hand tools.

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact including:

- consulting directly affected residents
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using solar-powered lighting towers if street lighting is inadequate
- using noise blankets as appropriate.

As part of this work, there will be night closures of two southbound lanes on Pennant Hills between the Hills M2 Motorway and Murray Farm Road, Beecroft.
