Day and night work: M1 Pacific Motorway widening, Wahroonga

Dear resident,

As part of the M1 Pacific Motorway widening, work is continuing to build the new northbound lane arrangement, noise walls, southbound tunnel entry ramp and northbound tunnel exit ramp.

The main work activities include installing barriers, hoarding, signage, lights and signals; tree clearing, excavating, relocating and installing services and drainage; constructing road pavement, piling, concreting, asphaltting, saw cutting, hammering, line marking, replacing noise walls and building the tunnel dive structures.

This work will be carried out on the M1 and next to the motorway between Pennant Hills Road and 300 metres north of Alexandria Parade Bridge, Wahroonga. A map of the area is provided.

Generally, this work will be carried out during standard construction hours from 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturday, however to ensure the safety of motorists and workers, work will also be carried out at night between 8pm and 5am.

It is expected that M1 widening work will continue for up to six months, weather permitting. During this time northbound traffic will be diverted on to the new alignment. Tunnelling and associated above ground work activities will continue 24 hours a day in accordance with project approvals.

Plant and equipment for this work includes cranes, excavators, bob cat, piling rig, jack hammers, surface profilers, paving machines, heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, generators, scaffolding, rattle guns, hammer drills, grinders, concrete trucks, vacuum truck, street sweepers, water carts and pumps, elevated work platforms, concrete saws and pumps, core drills, line marking and removal plant, as well as hand tools.

You will experience noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > providing respite for residents most affected by noise
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use

- > using solar-powered lighting towers where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.
