Night work – Pennant Hills Road southbound tunnel portal

Dear resident

As part of ongoing work to build the NorthConnex southbound tunnel exit, night work to pour concrete will be carried out on Pennant Hills Road between Copeland Road and the Hills M2 Motorway. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

Work will start **from 4pm Saturday 14 October and continue through to 6am Sunday 15 October**, weather permitting. In the event of delays, the work will be carried out on the next available Saturday and Sunday. The night work hours are required to reduce impacts on road users and ensure the safety of workers and motorists. Residents are encouraged to register for SMS updates by contacting us on **1800 997 057** or enquiries@northconnex.com.au.

The main work activity will be the delivery and pouring of about 88 loads of concrete until about 2am. The concrete will then be left to set.

Plant and equipment for this work includes a crane, concrete vibrator needles, vibrating screeds, concrete pumps, light vehicles, lighting towers, vacuum truck, generators, excavators, trucks, rollers, concrete trucks, street sweeper, water cart, concrete saws and hand tools.

You may experience some noise during some of these activities and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and machinery when not in use
- > performing the noisiest activities early in the shift where possible
- > completing as much work as possible in the day shifts leading up to the concrete pour.

Subject to approval, there will be lane closures on Pennant Hills Road southbound as part of this work between 9pm Saturday 14 October and 6am Sunday 15 October. Traffic management and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers.
