Day work: Temporary closure of the footpath between Woonona Avenue and Benson Close, Wahroonga

Dear Resident,

As part of the construction of the Northern Ventilation Facility, the project team is building permanent drainage. This involves the adjustment of existing sewerage and water services in Benson Close and will require temporary closure of the footpath between Benson Close and Woonona Avenue.

A map of the work area is provided.

Additional services that needed relocation were identified during the work, as a result the footpath is now expected to be reopened by Friday 29 November 2019, weather permitting.

Pedestrian footpath closure

The pedestrian footpath between the cul-de-sacs at the ends of Woonona Avenue and Benson Close, Wahroonga will continue to be closed.

Temporary pedestrian diversions remain in place via Fern Avenue, Bundarra Avenue and Alexandria Avenue, Wahroonga. If you travel along this route, please allow extra time and follow the directional signage.

Driveway access to some properties in Benson Close will remain limited during this time. Residents in Benson Close will continue to receive further targeted notifications from NorthConnex.

The main work activities include:

- > trimming vegetation
- > excavating and trenching
- > rock hammering

Work hours

7am to 6pm Monday to Friday,
8am to 1pm Saturdays

For the safety of motorists and workers, work may be carried out outside of these hours, in line with our environmental approvals.

Tunnel excavation, associated above ground activities and access to compounds is carried out **24 hours a day**.

How will the work affect you?

The footpath will remain closed, the alternative route is outlined below.

You will experience some noise and we will make every effort to minimise impacts by:

- > consulting with directly affected residents
- > using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- > turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- > using noise blankets where possible
- > directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

Plant and equipment

The project team will use heavy and light vehicles, generators, excavators, jackhammers, grinders, concrete trucks, street sweepers, water carts, vacuum trucks, and removal plant, power and hand tools.
